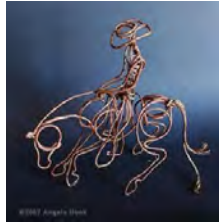

Session 7 - August 9 – August 13

Ages 5-14

Wire Inspire - Using wire and a variety of other objects such as sea glass, stones crystals and more, participants will twist, mould and wrap to create sculptural pieces, jewellery, sun catchers and more.



Session 8 - August 16 – August 20

Ages 5-14

Fantasy Faces: Gargoyles – Gargoyles are faces made of stone found at the top of buildings and towers. Participants will design and plan for their own gargoyles, and by using different materials they will create their own sky creature.



Session 9 - August 23 – August 27

Ages 5-14

Art and Nature Camp-Explore Nature and Art by creating with paint, clay, collage, sculpture and much more. We will also explore how nature influences artists by creating artwork out of natural materials.

Session 1 – June 28 – July 2

Ages 5 – 14

Art in Wonderland – Inspired by Lewis Carroll's *Alice's Adventure in Wonderland*, participants will create magical masks and other fantastical art. The week will end in a Mad Hatter's Party.



Session 2 - July 5 – July 9

Ages 5-14

Paint like Picasso - Participants will learn about abstract art. They will use a variety of tools and materials to create their own original abstract masterpiece.



Session 3 - July 12 – July 16

Ages 10-14

Say cheese!

The best way to learn photography is to go out taking pictures. Participants will learn about different styles of photography by exploring the neighbourhood. In addition to their photographs, they will use transfer techniques, collage and more to create a mixed media work of art.

Session 4 - July 19 – July 23

Ages 10-14

Claynimator- Participants will draw original storyboards, as well as design and build their own characters and sets, using a variety of materials including plasticine, *Lego* and found objects. They will create their own mini-action clay animation video by exploring the principles of stop motion photography and computer animation.
